The pediatric hemato-oncology unit is specialized in treatment of children and adolescents with:

- Cancer (solid tumors and leukemia's) ;
- Benign hematological diseases;
- Hemophilia and other coagulation disorders ;
- Immunological deficiencies (in exception of HIV) ;
- Rheumatic diseases, arthritis, auto-immune and inflammatory disorders ;
- Disorders requiring hematopoietic stem cell transplantations.

The pediatric Hemato-Oncology unit treats all the patients with a hemato-oncology pathology through inter and pluridisciplinary approach.

The unit is an Oncology reference center and member of the BSPHO (Belgian Society of Pediatric Hematology and Oncology) with approximately 70 new malignancies/year; and JACIE accredited for the HSCT unit with approximately 20 HSCT's/year

It has also a considerable activity in immunology and benign hematology. The hospital is a recognized hemophilia treatment center.

The unit consists of:

- 18 beds in hospitalization whereof 5 beds in the sterile HSCT unit.
  - 18 beds in day-hospitalization and a consultation unit
- 

### Principal Duties:

1. Provide the clinical care in day and conventional hospitalization to children, adolescents and young adults with a hemato-oncology pathology and manage consultations
2. Participation to the « on-call » week and weekend rotation
3. Participation to the pluridisciplinary oncology meetings
4. Teaching participation and participation in scientific publications
5. Active participation in clinical trials and translational research
6. Active participation in national and international Hemato-Oncology committees

Duties and responsibilities are not limited to the above description
