### **PRACTICAL DETAILS:**

- **Location** : Villa consulaire (*Salle Maurice Devignée*) [Quai de la Boverie 1 - 4000 LIEGE](#)

- **How to get there:**

○ By Public transportation => The easiest way to get there as it is only 10min walk from Liège Guillemins station. From the station, go straight on l'Esplanade, keep left from Finances tower (only building in front of the station). Come across la Meuse using pedestrian bridge “La belle Liégeoise”.

○ By Car

⇒ Parking on the street (rue du Parc / Place d'Italie or Quai de Rome / Av. Blondin and cross the pedestrian bridge)

⇒ Public parking => Médiacité, which is 5 min away walking.
